Vision and Mission Statement

Vision Statement

This vision statement describes the long-run objective of your company, usually for a time frame of five to ten years or even longer.

Mission Statement

A mission statement is like a road map of how to achieve the goals set in your vision statement. It defines the purpose of the organization

The vision of Christ in me International

At Christ in me International our vision is to establish the Kingdom of GOD on the earth, to fill the earth with the Glory of GOD and to equip, edify and raise up mankind in Christ as the image and the likeness of GOD.

This was the same vision GOD had in mind the day HE created the heaven and the earth. Gen 1:26 Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth."

GOD desired a 'GOD kind of people' through whom HE could establish HIS Kingdom in the earth to fill all the earth with HIS glory (weight, view, judgement and opinion)

Christ in Me International Mission

Establish the church as the body of Christ for the work of ministry by raising a GOD-appointed and perfect Five Fold, who as mature Sons of GOD work together in protecting and guarding Christ, until all come to the unity of faith and knowledge of the Son of GOD, unto the measure and stature of the fullness of Christ.

To establish and preach the Gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of GOD.

To establish Christ in Me International as a representative Household of Faith and ambassador of Christ, and to reveal the mystery which has been hidden from all ages and to make known what are the riches of the glory of the mystery which is: Christ in you, the hope of glory.

Working from GOD'S perspective

When it comes to creation, we need to work from the CREATOR's perspective. We need to understand HIS doings and HIS desire. We need to know and work with HIS **vision and HIS mission.**

If not, one will work with perceptions and theories. This will inevitably lead to the destruction of HIS creation purpose.

Where there is no vision, people perish...

Hos 4:6 My people are destroyed for lack of **knowledge** (da'ath, H1847 - discernment, understanding, wisdom) . Because you have rejected knowledge, I also will reject you from being priest for Me; Because you have forgotten the law of your God, I also will forget your children.

Knowledge - H1847 comes from the root word 'yâda' (H3045)

H3045 - to perceive and see, to find out and to discern... in other words, they perish because they are blind.

2Cor 4:3

But even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing, (4) whose minds the god of this age has blinded (mentally blind), who do not believe, lest the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine on them.

2 Cor 3:15-18

...a veil lies on their heart. (16) Nevertheless when one turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away. (17) Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty. (18) But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord.

The darkness or the veil appeared when man lost the light, the glory of GOD by eating of the forbidden fruit... a different knowledge than the knowledge of GOD, the knowledge of good and evil.

Rom 3:23 ...for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

This was that very moment that man became mentally blinded and veiled. We didn't lose our physical sight, we lost GOD's vision, HIS glory. Subsequently, the mission of GOD through the creation of man, to fill the earth with HIS glory, could no longer be accomplished.

The solution for this blindness and these veiled mindsets starts with...

Heb 10:19-20

Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus, (20) by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, **through the veil, that is, His flesh**

**...but it ends when we receive the end of our faith, the
salvation of our souls (1Pet 1:9)**

Heb 9:28 so Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many. To those who eagerly wait for Him He will appear a second time, apart from sin, for salvation.

The 1st coming of Christ came through Jesus Christ, the sacrifice for sin. The 2nd coming of Christ is not the physical return of Jesus. It is a salvation, the salvation of our souls. In other words, the knowledge of GOD revealed through the Christ specie, the harvest of the Christ seed. (This is our mission, to be raised up and to raise up the Christ specie through the knowledge of GOD)

- **Joh 12:24**

Most assuredly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the ground and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it produces much grain (the same specie).

- **Romans 8:18-19**

For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us. (19) For the earnest expectation of the creation eagerly waits for the revealing of the sons of God (the harvest).

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The word 'mission' as a noun, can have different prefix's added to it which changes the meaning of the word, for example...

- Sub-mission
- Co-mission
- Re-mission

Mission...

An important assignment given to a person or a group of people. A strongly felt aim, ambition or calling.

Commission

An instruction, command or role given to a person or a group. It's a common mission.

Example: The Commission of Truth and reconciliation had a common mission, to find truth and establish reconciliation.

Submission

The prefix 'sub' means – under. A **submarine** for instance travels under the sea. A **subway** is a way to travel “under” a city. A subterranean cave is “under” the earth. When you have a **subpar** performance, it means your performance is “under” what it should be.

1Pet 5:5 Likewise you younger people, submit (G5293) yourselves to your elders. Yes all of you be submissive to one another, and be clothed with humility, for "God resists the proud, But gives grace to the humble."

G5293

hupotassō - to arrange under, to subordinate, to subject, put in subjection, to subject one's self, obey, to submit to one's control, to obey, be subject.

Remission

The prefix 're' in repent has the meaning of, again and again, to indicate repetition, or with the meaning "back" or "backwards" to indicate withdrawal or backward motion; regenerate, refurbish, retype, retrace, revert. Remission as a noun also means, the cancellation of debt, charge or penalty.

Remission - G859 - aphasis

- 1) release from bondage or imprisonment
- 2) forgiveness or pardon, of sins (letting them go as if they had never been committed), remission of the penalty.

Remission of sin

Mat 26:28 For this is My blood of the new covenant, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.

Sin - G266

Hamartia... to miss the mark, to err, to be mistaken.

Remission – ‘re’, to repeat, to reverse, to return to the mission, that of GOD’s... one mission... HIS.

Through the submission of Jesus Christ to the will and the vision of his FATHER, he brought remission of sin to us all. We can again live a life not missing the mark.

Being an example of us (not for us), we have a common mission. To be in submission to the will of GOD, to proclaim the remission of sin to all and to fill the earth with HIS glory through repentance to righteousness.

Luke 24:45-47

And He opened their understanding, that they might comprehend the Scriptures. (46)
Then He said to them, "Thus it is written, and thus it was necessary for the Christ to suffer and to rise from the dead the third day, (47) and that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.

Our one mission is to repent to righteousness (the state we/ everything ought to be), not missing the mark anymore but to answer to the vision of GOD our FATHER by filling the earth with HIS glory.

2 Peter 3:10-13

But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night, in which the heavens will pass away with a great noise, and the elements (G4747 the first principles) will melt with fervent heat; both the earth and the works that are in it will be burned up. (Heb 12:29... our GOD is a consuming fire

(11) Therefore, since all these things will be dissolved, what manner of persons ought you to be in holy conduct and godliness,

(12) looking for and hastening the coming of the day of God, because of which the heavens will be dissolved, being on fire, and the elements will melt with fervent heat?

(13) Nevertheless we, according to His promise, look for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells.

God's mission is to reclaim the world--and that includes the created order--and we as God's people have a designated role to play in that mission.

- **Ps 24:1** A Psalm of David. The earth is the Lord's, and all its fullness, The world and those who dwell therein.
- **1Cor 10:26** for "the earth is the Lord's, and all its fullness."
- **Num 14:21** but truly, as I live, all the earth shall be filled with the glory of the Lord

EXODUS 19:5, 6

Now if you will listen to Me and carefully keep My covenant, you will be My own possession out of all the peoples, although all the earth is Mine, and you will be My kingdom of priests and My holy nation. (1 Pet 2:9)

ISAIAH 6:8

Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying: Who should I send? Who will go for Us? (who can I commission) I said: Here I am. Send me.

2 Cor 13:11

Finally, brethren, farewell. Become complete. Be of good comfort, be of one mind, live in peace (Day 7); and the God of love and peace will be with you.
